

COVID-19 VACCINE NEED-TO-KNOW DETAILS

It is **SAFE**

The available COVID-19 vaccines are approved and recommended by the FDA and the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices following standard testing and approval processes.



It is **FREE**

Don't trust scammers! The COVID-19 vaccine is free of charge to all individuals by the federal government. Insurance information may be asked but you will not be charged. If you don't have insurance, you're still eligible to receive the free vaccine.



It is **TWO** doses to be **FULLY** vaccinated

Until you are fully vaccinated, you can still contract and spread COVID-19. It will take time for everyone who wants a COVID-19 vaccination to get one. Continuing the safety preventative measures is important even after your second dose.



The two doses must be done from the **SAME SITE**

You must receive your second dose of the same vaccine at the same site as your first dose of the vaccine. Before leaving your first dose appointment, schedule or confirm how and when to setup your next appointment.



Talk to **medical professionals**

There is an overwhelming amount of wrong information and misconceptions being spread around. If there are any questions or concerns, please advise to your medical professional and not the internet or unverified rumors.
