National Grid work on Lakeside Ave to limit parking at Lakeside Apartments

WORCESTER, MA—As part of the ongoing redevelopment of Lakeside Apartments, crews for National Grid will be performing utility work along Lakeside Avenue that will temporarily limit on-street parking and impact traffic flow.

Work Schedule:

- **Monday, December 22 & Tuesday, December 23**
🕒 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- **Work pauses for Christmas**
- **Monday, December 29 & Tuesday, December 30**
🕒 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- **Weeks of January 5, 2026 and January 12, 2026**
Five workdays each week
🕒 7:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Work will begin at the intersection of **Lovell Street and Lakeside Avenue** and progress toward **Coes Pond**, including sidewalk areas and the crossing at **Veterans Avenue**.

What Residents Should Know:

- Parking along the **north (building) side of Lakeside Avenue** (a City of Worcester street) will be restricted.
🚧 **Vehicles parked in the designated work zone WILL be towed by the City.**
- Parking on the **south (canal) side of Lakeside Avenue** is currently permitted.
- A **single travel lane** for cars and buses will remain open at all times.

About the Work:

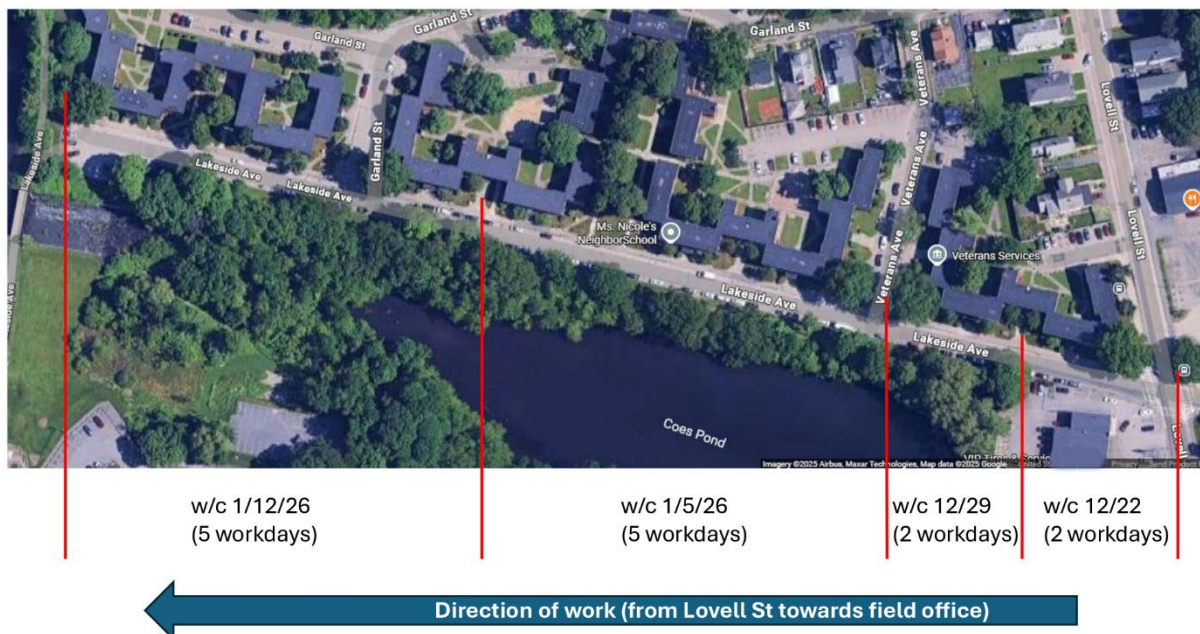
Crews will excavate a trench, install National Grid conduit, pour concrete to secure it, and restore pavement by the end of each workday.
