What is a Mentor?

A mentor is a caring & responsible role model who takes time to form a friendship with a young person. Mentors know that young people can make a positive difference in the world if given the chance.

LUK Mentors are carefully screened and trained adult volunteers.

Mentors spend at least one hour per week with their Mentee for at least one year. They also receive support from a LUK Mentoring Specialist.



In community-based Mentoring, Mentors spend time in the community doing a variety of activities with their youth Mentees.

Why does my child need a Mentor?

There are many reasons a youth might need or want a mentor.

All young people need the support of caring adults in order to be successful. Sometimes, youth need an adult outside the family to share their thoughts with, help practice social skills, and build community connections.

Mentors can:

- Introduce new interests and experiences
- Promote growth and self confidence
- Be an outside connection to talk to

Youth with mentors are more likely to:

- Graduate from high school
- Volunteer in the community
- Enroll in college
- Be hopeful about their future

Youth with mentors improve:

- School attendance
- Academic success
- Behavior at home and school
- Relationships with adults
- Relationships with peers
- Self-esteem and confidence
