Recommended Items to Pack for Temporary Relocation

This checklist is intended to help residents prepare for a temporary hotel or off-site relocation. Please pack only essential items and what you will need for daily living.

Important Documents & Essentials

- Identification (ID, driver's license, passport)
- Insurance cards (health, Medicare/Medicaid, prescription)
- Wallet – including credit and debit cards
- Medication list (with dosages and prescribing doctors)
- Emergency contact list
- Doctor and PCA contact information
- Valuables that are not locked in a safe
- Hotel confirmation / relocation paperwork
- Vaccination record (for pharmacies or urgent care visits)

Medications & Health Needs

- All daily medications (in original bottles if possible)
- Medical equipment and chargers (walker, cane, wheelchair, oxygen, CPAP, etc.)
- Extra batteries/chargers for medical devices
- Glasses, spare eyeglasses, and cleaning supplies
- Hearing aids and extra batteries
- Masks

Clothing & Personal Items

- Comfortable clothing (plan for 2–3 weeks of clothes, coin-operated laundry available)
- Sleepwear and slippers

- Jacket/Coat
- Undergarments and socks
- Comfortable shoes
- Accessories (hats, gloves, belts, jewelry)
- Laundry bag (for used clothing)

Toiletries & Hygiene

- Toothbrush, toothpaste, denture care items
- Soap, shampoo, conditioner
- Deodorant, lotion
- Hairbrush/comb
- Make-up
- Nail clippers
- Blow dryer
- Tissues
- First aid kit (band-aids, pain relievers, antacids, over-the-counter medications)
- Men grooming tools/kits

Food & Kitchen Supplies

- Perishable foods
- Special dietary items (if needed)
- Spices for cooking
- Food storage supplies (zip bags, plastic wrap, containers)
- Dish towels / sponges / Dish Soap
- Paper towels / napkins

Electronics & Comfort Items

- Cell phone & charger
- Extension cords / power strip
- Tablet, laptop, or radio (optional)
- Reading materials
- Supplies for service animal (food, bowl, leash, medications)
- Hobby items (sketch book, knitting, games)

Household & Laundry

- Laundry detergent or pods
- Dryer sheets

- Cleaning supplies
- Reusable water bottle
- Pen/pencil/notepad

Transportation & Communication

- List of nearby pharmacies, urgent care, and grocery stores - To be provided by WHA.
- Printed hotel address/room number (for emergencies or family)

Financial & Miscellaneous

- Checkbook or cash if needed
- Extra keys / Mailbox keys
